

### *How to register?*

Your RSL club will need to register the at [bbqtoremember.com](http://bbqtoremember.com)

Cost-\$500 (which licenses your venue to use BBQtoRemember marketing)

### *Who will run and host the BBQ?*

The sub-Branch members are to run and host the BBQ.

### *Sub-Branches with no RSL club attached?*

Register your BBQ at [bbqtoremember.com](http://bbqtoremember.com) and start fundraising.

### *Where does the fundraising money go?*

- i. All funds raised at the RSL sub-Branch BBQ remain with the sub-Branch.
- ii. All digital fundraising goes to Swiss8 so they can deliver mental health tools to Australian veterans.

### *Grants may be available for sub-Branches to apply for*

The Department of Veteran Affairs currently have a few grants which sub-Branches may be eligible to apply for and use funds for the BBQ. Sub-Branches will need to apply for the grant and provide it to their attached RSL Club who will register the BBQ at a cost of \$500. To find out what's available go to <https://www.dva.gov.au/>
